# Yellow Miniflora



**Yellow Miniflora** known for its compact, free-flowering shrubs that produce numerous clusters of small, vibrant yellow blooms, ideal for containers, borders, and small garden patches.

The featured image is taken from a **2 months** old plant, my father bought it from a local nursery, in occasion of my mother's 48th birthday. Growing this rose in very humid weather it is in Sundarbans, West Bengal, India. Where in December 2025-January 2026, temperature was between 12-20°C, normally. And winter is the best time to enjoy the beauty of roses in this location.

Its a repeat bloomer, and produces beautiful yellow flowers. Can be grown in pot, preferred minimum 8-10 inch parallel terracotta pots for a mature plant. It features healthy, dense, green foliage. Its a highly disease-resistant variant.

Based on my observation the plant grows very well in full sun condition, and can expect flowers throughout the year, though the bloom form and colour depends upon cool weather condition.

If you are planning for rose borders or patches, with yellow roses then this one can be one of the best roses in the category with very minimum maintenance.



## Key details – how to identify:

- **Bloom** - Small medium-sized, old-fashioned, blooms.
- **Colour** - Vibrant Yellow core with faded apricot outer petals.
- **Habit** - Small and bushy, takes very less space and minimum care.
- **Foliage** - Features very glossy and green foliage.
